




#### Baseball Mound Renovation

- 1. Excavate table and landing areas to three to four inch depth.
- 2. Apply DuraPitch® Mound Clay.
- 3. Add water to achieve desired consistency.
- 4. Work moisture into clay and compact until firm.




#### Softball Pitching Area

- Excavate one foot behind and 8 feet on front of pitching rubber, approx.
   feet 4 inches wide.
- 2. Apply DuraPitch® Mound Clay.
- 3. Add water to achieve desired consistency.
- 4. Work moisture into clay and compact until firm.




#### Home Plate Area

- 1. Batters boxes: Excavate 4 feet by 6 feet area, 3 inches deep. Catchers box: Excavate 3 feet 7 inches by 8 feet area, 3 inches deep.
- 2. Apply DuraPitch® Mound Clay.
- 3. Add water to achieve desired consistency.
- 4. Work moisture into clay and compact until firm.
